ZACHARY HUTCHINSON: Not Telling!

For this exhibition, boundary is *Not Telling!* with a show consisting of sculpture, photography, video and (maybe) some drawings by Zachary Hutchinson. Her new body of work comes through costume making, theater, video making and an obsessive attention to image and transgressive affect. By endless hours of searching Ebay for mid '80s to 90s crafty sewing patterns, she creates dolls that recall the tradition of these rudimentary crafts but stripping the decorative. These objects shift to become eerie interpretations of this subset of handmade craft in which the actual construction of the original crafts and subsequently Hutchinson's involvement with materials are integral to the work. "From the positioning of my queer body against ruffly domestic craft world I've found a liminal space of uncomfortable domesticity. What hides behind the gathers and ribbons?" We look forward to what may be revealed.
